

2020 Land Ops Cuddeback Nav-Comm Operation - COVID19 Plan

- All participants, including staff, friends or family attending with event participates and volunteer screenings will be asked the below questions before arrival via phone or email.
 - o In the last 14 days have you had a fever greater than 101.4, shortness of breath, body aches or coughing (not attributable to allergies) or been diagnosed with COVID 19 (presumptive or positive test)?
 - o If so, do not attend event
- In the last 14 days have you had close contact with someone who may have COVID-19) This includes anyone with a positive COVID-19 test or who has COVID-19 symptoms (fever greater than 101.4, shortness of breath, body aches or coughing, (not attributable to allergies))?
 - o If so, do not attend event
- In the last 14 days have you assisted in the care of an individual (outside your household) who is not well
 - o If so and you were wearing proper PPE (Including N95 mask), please take extra caution by maintaining strict social distance and wearing face covering
 - o If so and you were NOT wearing PPE do not attend event.
- In the last 14 days have you returned from another country or high-risk area?
 - o If so, do not attend event
- All staff, volunteers, and participants should stay home if sick or any of the answers above are affirmative.
- Use of face coverings/masks by staff, volunteers, and participants is required anytime they are outside of their individual camp.
- Initiate, practice, and remind others of social distancing.
 - Campers will be encouraged to keep 60 feet between camps
 - When outside of own camp, avoid physical contact, handshaking, hugging etc.
 - Children should remain in care of their own household members.
 - Conduct briefings and conversations outdoors and at least 6 feet apart.
- Due to the COVID19 restrictions this year's Cuddeback Nav-Comm Operation will be different then past years.
 - No organized group potluck will take place.
 - Individuals are always encouraged to keep at least 6 feet between others.
- Net Control staff will practice social distancing and wear face coverings at all times when in the company of others.
- Drivers meetings will be conducted outdoors, and everyone must stay at least 6 feet apart and wear face coverings.
- When searching for Caches, please be aware of your distance between other Operators and wear your mask. It is suggested to use hand sanitizer after touching objects that others may have previously touched. In other words, you will be expected to exhibit safe behavior based on CDC Guidelines and other common sense actions as described herein.
