Thank you for joining this Land Ops event at Cuddeback Lake. This trip update includes important information so that you can arrive at the Base Camp without getting lost (hopefully!).



The Base Camp and Net Control will be located near Fremont Peak, which is at the South end of Cuddeback Lake. The entrance to the area is off Hwy 395, and it will take about 40 minutes from the road to reach the base camp. The important waypoints are as follows:

Cuddeback Lake is a primitive area, so you will want to be sure to bring plenty of water as well as the usual primitive camping supplies. There are no facilities at the base camp. Be sure to bring a handheld gps for finding the caches and your ham radio if you are licensed, and if not, bring an FRS radio. Net Control will be monitoring 145.555 simplex and the Big Bear Repeater 147.330+ with PL 131.8. Net Control will also monitor FRS Channel 1 (no privacy tone).
